Epilepsy is one of the most common neurological diseases, affecting more than 50 million people around the world



ARE DIAGNOSED

with epilepsy each year; 50-60% of cases have no known cause



PEOPLE EACH DAY

are diagnosed with epilepsy in Canada



NEWLY DIAGNOSED

are young children and seniors





A seizure is not always a medical emergency; call 911 if a seizure last longer than 5 minutes





1 in 100 people with epilepsy will die each year from SUDEP - Sudden Unexpected Death in Epilepsy



People with epilepsy experience increased rates of mental health challenges compared to the general population including depression and anxiety
